### **Ring One – Ridden**

#### **Start 9.00am – Judge: Emma Matthews**

##### **Class 1 – First Ridden/Lead Rein**

Open to Children 10 Years or under on the 01/01/2018. Ponies not exceeding 138cm and Lead Rein to be attached to noseband. No Cantering.

##### **Class 2 – Ridden Veteran's**

Open to all Horse and Ponies – Aged 15 Years +

##### **Class 3 – Ridden Riding Horse & Hunter's**

Open to all Riding Horses and Hunter's. Class will be split if entries warrant.

##### **Class 4 – Ridden Part Breds**

Open to all Part Bred Horses and Ponies.

#### **Not before 11.00am – Judge: Emma Matthews**

##### **Class 5 – Ridden Foreign Breeds**

Open to all Foreign Breeds of Horses and Ponies.

##### **Class 6 – Ridden Family Horse/Pony**

Open to all Horse/Ponies that are ridden and shared between family members.

##### **Class 7 – Ridden Mountain & Moorlands**

Open to all M&M Breeds (Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C & D) Horses and Ponies – class will be split if entries warrant.

#### **Not before 1.00pm – Judge: Emma Matthews**

##### **Class 8 – Ridden Novice**

Open to all Novice combinations – not to have gained three 1<sup>st</sup>.

##### **Class 9 – Ridden Retraining of Racehorses**

Open to all Thoroughbreds who have raced, raced overseas or unraced and are Registered RoR.

##### **Class 10 – Ridden Coloured's**

Open to all Horses and Ponies. Piebald/Skewbald/Roan/Palomino/Paint/Spot etc. The winner of this class will receive a Voucher from Centaur Sport's Therapy.

##### **Class 11 – Ridden Cob's**

Open to all Cobs - Horses and Ponies.

##### **Class 12 – Ridden Veteran Rider**

Open to all Riders aged 45 and over.

##### **Class 13 – Ridden Rescue Horse/Pony**

Open to all Horse and Ponies that have been rescued by an Equine Charity.

Open to all Foreign breeds of Horses and Ponies.

#### **Class 17 – Miniatures and Shetlands In-Hand**

Open to all Miniatures Under 42” and Shetland Ponies.

#### **Class 18 – Family Horse/Pony In-hand**

Open to all Horse/Ponies that are ridden and shared between family members.

#### **Class 19 – Junior Handler’s**

Open to all children aged 10 to 16 years old.

#### **Class 20 – Veteran’s In-hand**

Open to all Horse and Ponies – Aged 15 Years +.

Open to all heavy horses.

### Rules – Competing under BSPS Rules:

Safety: Hard hats, to at least PAS105, SNELL E2001, ASTMf1163 standards must be worn at all times when mounted on the show ground.

Neither the volunteers, nor any judge or steward or other official, shall be liable for injury to the person, or the horse or other personal property of any competitor, spectator, or other person, however arising. It is an express condition of entry that each competitor shall hold the staff, judges, stewards and other officials harmless in respect of all such injury or damage.

We ask that you remain aware of other showground users at all times – please refrain from gathering around gateways/passageways and warn others if your horse is known to kick (red ribbon tail).

Entries: **The Decision of the Judges is Final.**

**No Stallions permitted on showground.**

No Entry Refund will be given. In the event of classes clashing or running late, entry fees will not be refunded; competitors must choose carefully which classes they want to compete in.

Entrants arriving late will not be admitted into a class unless at the judge's discretion.

Smart and correct dress to be worn when competing.

Proof of age may be required in appropriate classes. (Passports should be supplied with horses on request when travelling).

Showground: Authorised officials and competitors only are allowed in the ring.

No Lunging, Canter or Galloping in the car park is strictly prohibited. Anyone violating this rule is liable to be disqualified from all classes, with no refund of entry fees.

When warming up in the collecting ring, please follow the British Riding School Rules – Left to Left etc.

All dogs to be kept on leads at all times.

Please take your litter home with you.

Do not skip out horse boxes and trailers onto the ground.

Children must be supervised at all times.

No water available on site – **Please Bring Your Own Water!**
